- 2 erasers - white, pink or pearl
- 1 watercolor set (Prang brand is best)
- Set of colored pencils, 12 or 24 count (Faber-Castell, Derwent, Prismacolor, Crayola brands preferred)
- 1 1-gallon Ziploc bag

Choir:

- 1 plastic 2-pocket folder
- 1 Pencil to stay in the folder

Orchestra:

- 1 inch black binder
- 1 package 5 tab dividers
- 2 Pencils to stay in the orchestra binder
- Rosin
- Violinists/Violists – shoulder rest (sponge is okay)
- Bassists/Cellists – rock stop

Band:

- Pencil to stay in folder
- Reed instruments – box of reeds (#2.5 or 3) and appropriate cleaning supplies
- Brass instruments – slide/valve oil and grease
