Homework Expectations: SCPA curriculum is an academically rigorous and content-rich, language based program. The homework is independent practice of concepts previously learned. Through students’ independent completion of their homework, teachers get valuable insight into concepts that need review. Please do not “correct” homework for your child, rather re-direct attention back to what should be reviewed.

Inclement Weather & School Closing: St. Croix Prep is dependent upon ISD 834 (Stillwater) for bus transportation. Because of this, St. Croix Prep will close when the Stillwater closes their schools. St. Croix Prep and Stillwater currently provide WCCO-4, KSTP-5 and KARE-11 with school closing information. We recommend tuning to these TV stations and their websites (www.wcco.com; www.kstp.com; www.kare11.com) for school alert information. We will also post our school closing information on our website.

Non-Uniform Days: On Non-Uniform days, students may wear clothes other than their standard uniform. We ask that students be respectful, appropriate and demonstrate neatness, cleanliness, and modesty in their appearance on non-uniform days. No hats allowed. Non-uniform days for the year are:

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Spirit Wear Days: To enhance school spirit and build a closer community, St. Croix Prep will have days when students may wear Spirit Wear in lieu of their uniform. 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School Hours: The school doors open at 9:00am. Students will be allowed to enter the building at that time. Any Lower School student arriving prior to 9:00 am will be required to attend the YMCA before-care program. All fees will apply in the event your child attends the YMCA program. All Lower School students MUST be supervised. Students with Middle/Upper School siblings are allowed to wait in the atrium with an older sibling if the older sibling is providing supervision. All other students need to be supervised in the cafeteria from 9:00am - 9:15am. Unless students have after school activities, they will not be allowed building access after 4:15pm. Classes operate from 9:30am - 4:00pm. Any Lower School student who remains after school without supervision will be required to attend the YMCA after-care program beginning at 4:15 pm. All fees will apply in the event your child attends the YMCA program.
