- 2 erasers - white, pink or pearl
- 1 watercolor set (Prang brand if possible)

- 1 plastic 2-pocket folder
- 1 Pencil to stay in the folder

Orchestra:

- 1 inch black binder
- 1 package 5 tab dividers
- 2 Pencils to stay in the orchestra binder
- Essential Elements 2000 Book II for designated instrument (available to purchase from Mr. Jeske)
- Rosin
- Violinists/Violists – shoulder rest (sponge is okay)
- Bassists/Cellists – rock stop

Band:

- Pencil to stay in folder
